From the Pastor

The worship service on Pentecost Sunday was a bit of a milestone for me; it was the first time I had held a confirmation service since my ordination nearly three years ago. There have been a few adults whom I have confirmed, but they have thus far forgone a formal induction service. The Russell triplets, therefore, are the first confirmands I have had the privilege of both instructing and inducting in a worship service.

It also felt like a milestone for the whole congregation, not just me. Quite a few people in the pews remember the triplets as newborns and most of the congregation have watched them grow up. But confirmation is not the end for the Russell girls; nor is confirmation simply a "graduation" for any believer. Confirmation is meant to prepare you for a life of faith and service as a participant in God's Church on Earth.

Moving forward in the faith, the Russell girls and the Novakovics boys recently formed a youth group at Hope Lutheran Church. Emily Russell's debriefing of what the five of them have thus far decided appears below in this newsletter. Essentially, these youth enjoyed coming together in fellowship following confirmation classes and decided to keep the camaraderie going. I am proud of them for taking this step and I will be supporting the group as an advisor... and once we assemble

the foosball table together, I will be the resident foosball champ. (Just try and stop me, kids!)

Our youth are moving forward and making plans for the future, and it does the heart good knowing there is a future for our congregation, by the grace of God. It is God who abides with us in good and bad. We depend on Him and He is faithful to us. Come what may, the Lord will supply us with His grace and love. This is what He has promised through Christ. Joined to Christ in the holy fellowship of faith, we will always have our Lord by our side guiding us in eternal life. And we need this blessed news as Hope Lutheran faces some hard decisions ahead.

Like the youth, our congregation also must move forward in the faith. There are practical concerns to consider, such as the fact we are a smaller congregation than we used to be prepandemic and the fact our finances are projected to fall significantly short of our expenses. However, this is not new news. These things were discussed in the last couple of Congregation Meetings, and they will be major discussion points during our upcoming meeting on June 11. Putting together a comprehensive plan to address the issues we face will take a long time and should have input from everyone within the congregation, but, at the June meeting, we can at least focus on choosing which direction we want to take.

Let us continue looking forward to our hope in Christ by building on our congregation of Hope. We know our Lord will guard and protect us, so we trust that He will guide us as we do our best to extend His ministry in Victoria. Thusly we may deal with the practical matters of the congregation regarding finances, property, and outreach.

The Parish Planning Council has run through a few different possibilities for the congregation to consider and has gathered some preliminary information on some options for us. Some options presented thus far have included: selling our building and moving elsewhere, selling the parking lot to developers, and having our property redeveloped into an apartment complex with our church on the ground floor (similar to Redeemer Lutheran in Langford).

Making a decision on what to do will take some time to digest and much discussion. Therefore, please come to the Congregation Meeting on June 11 and also look for upcoming announcements with more information to discuss our future as a congregation.


