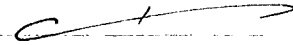

Sunday School Record of the Evangelical
Lutheran Church at Victoria, B. C.

On the thirteenth of October, 1940, our first Sunday school was opened with nine pupils, all from unchurched homes in the neighborhood, found in the pastor's canvass. It was held in the temporary chapel at 1130 Hillside avenue. The first teachers were Mrs. J. S. Turner and Miss Frida Johnson, who conducted the Sunday School classes faithfully every Sunday morning at ten o'clock. and the Sunday School grew.

The first children's service was held on Christmas Eve, 1940, with the congregation taking part.

The congregation also enjoyed the first Sunday School picnic with the children at the Millers Beach in Victoria on the 13th of July, ¹⁹⁴¹ the total attendance was 51.

The first regular meeting of the Sunday School teachers was held on the 17th of October, 1941. Present were the Pastor, Rev. N. P. Dalling and the two teachers, Mrs. J. S. Turner and Mrs. J. K. Stollman. The meeting was held at the Stollman home, 1018 McCune St.

The meeting was opened with prayer by the Pastor. After introductory remarks the pastor gave a demonstration of how to present lesson

42 for October 19th on the Plagues, Passover, and Exodus of the Children of Israel from Egypt. All took part in the discussion.

It was decided to meet as a rule on every second and fourth Friday evening of the month at 7:30. The next meeting, however, is to be at the Hoollam home on the 7th of November at 7:30 p.m.

Our system of attendance records was then explained and discussed. One point is scored for each attendance. An extra point is added for each child brought along to enrol in the Sunday School. The score equal to a full year's attendance entitles the child to a reward, to be chosen by the teachers.

About eight dollars are now in the treasury and all material is paid for to the end of the year.

A number of hymns were selected for practice in preparation for Christmas. The teachers volunteered to bring whatever program material they have along to our next meeting.

After a number of different questions were freely discussed, the meeting closed on a cheerful and inspiring note.

The Sunday School teachers, Mrs. J. S. Turner, Mrs. J. K. Hoollam, and Pastor Daeling, met on the 7th of November, 1941, at the Hoollam home, 1018 McCune St., at 7:30 in the evening.

Prayer by the pastor opened the meeting. The record of the last meeting was read and approved. The Sunday School treasury now contains \$10.56. All Sunday School expenses are being paid from the Sunday School treasury. This includes all the material for the Sunday lessons, two subscriptions to the Concordia Sunday School Teachers' Quarterly, and awards for the children.

The pastor presented lesson 45, "The Giving of the Law," Exodus 19 and 20. A free discussion brought out many interesting and useful points for the presentation next Sunday.

For Christmas gifts to the children we ordered one dozen prayer-books entitled "Little Folded Hands" and one dozen entitled "Now I Lay Me Down to Sleep." Award suggestions for attendance and bringing others were then thoroughly looked into. It was agreed that Bible History Picture Books would be the best. The teachers will meet downtown next Thursday at two o'clock in order to examine material available for awards here in Victoria.

Plans for the 1941 Christmas program were then made. An informal program of our own arrangement and adaptation was decided on.
