The meeting was held at the home of Mrs. Turner, 870 Holliston St, Esquimalt, B.C. and opened with prayer by the Pastor. All three teachers were there, Mrs. Turner, Mrs. Stollam, and the Pastor.

For lesson preparation we read the Christmas story together from Luke 2 and Matthew 2 and noted the chief points which carry out the Father-family theme of our Christmas program.

She asked Mrs. Turner to wrap the two dozen prayerbooks, which we had ordered as gifts for the children from the Sunday School. She kindly consented.

The Pastor was asked to provide the Christmas tree for the chapel.

Final decisions were made on the hymns, carols, and other items of the Christmas Eve service.

Each meeting convinces us more of the need and benefit to ourselves and the Sunday School of these teachers' meetings. The next one will be held at the Stollam home, 2953 Tillicum Rd, on Friday evening, the 9th of January, 1942.
