13 January 1944

All regular teachers except Miss Cornea Oke were present at the Turner home for the first meeting in the New Year. Pastor Doelling led in an opening prayer. Minutes were read.

Two lessons were prepared in advance.

The treasurer reported about ten dollars in the SS treasury at present.

Our supply of attendance awards and left-over gifts was examined and separated for use in various classes.

Picturegraph numbers for the next two lessons were given to the teachers. And attention was again called to the necessity of keeping our figures properly numbered and filed away.

10 Feb. 1944

All regular teachers except Miss Cornea Oke were present at the parsonage for the regular meeting. The Pastor opened the meeting with prayer. The minutes were read.

He proceeded immediately to a detailed study of the Bible history "Jairus' Daughter" and a survey of the following lesson "Feeding of the 5000." Picturegraph numbers were then given to all teachers.

A suggestion on reviewing the previous lesson by Mrs. Doelling was welcomed by the teachers. The suggestion was to begin the class with a quick review, engaging the full attention of all pupils right from the start, by using the true and false questions and multiple choice questions at the end of the lesson and having the pupils answer by action devices, e. g. all stand to answer "yes" and sit to answer "no." Other devices are folded arms, crossed legs, shaking the head, etc. This may be followed by asking the statement questions after every lesson.

She determined the goal toward which each class is to strive in catechism memory work.

Our treasurer, Mrs. Turner, reminded the teachers to hand in their accounts for postage expended on cards & delinquents, etc.

Our profitable meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer in unison.

24th Feb. 1944

All teachers were present at the Simpson home for the regular meeting, which was opened with prayer, led by the pastor.

The thoroughly studied lesson on "Blind Bartimaeus" and "Zacchaeus." Picturegraph

numbers for the next lessons were then read for all the teachers.

A request was made for more catechisms in trade form. The pastor will provide them.

It was decided to give the remaining, unsold copies of Scripture Text Calendars to the Lutheran Home to be given to those who send in a contribution.

In order to encourage Sunday School children also to attend the service and to help toward a start we shall practice two hymns to be sung by the Sunday School in the Easter Sunday service.

In the Pastor's absence there will be no teachers' meeting on March 9th, but our next meeting will be on March 23rd at the Oke home, now 3534 Quadra St.

The very profitable meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer in unison.

Pastor Doelling

23 March 1944

All regular teachers and Mrs. Storer, substitute teacher, were present at the meeting, held at the Oke home. The pastor opened the meeting with prayer. The record of the previous meeting was read, as always, and tacitly approved.

The Pastor then presented brief notes on a quarterly review for next Sunday and then gave a detailed account of the lesson, viz. Savio's

death and burial. The teachers were urged to be especially well prepared to present most effectively the climax lessons of all Bible History, namely the suffering and death and resurrection of our Lord for us.

The pastor was asked to get new picturegraph material for future lessons.

It was reported that our Christmas card order had to be reduced twenty-five percent from last year by Government order. Our order for 1944 stands at 130 boxes of cards with twelve cards in a box. Twelve Scripture text calendars were ordered at the same time. The entire order was placed again with the Messenger Corporation of Toronto.

The teachers asked the Pastor to prepare a form letter for each teacher to copy and send home to each family represented in Sunday School, inviting them to attend the Easter Sunday morning service, at which the children will take part.

More catechisms in tract form are to be ordered.

Teachers, who need new attendance record material, are to report their needs at least a month in advance.

The next meeting is to be held at the Stoner home, 1023 Pandora, on the 13th of April. The closed with the Lord's Prayer.

All teachers except Mrs. Simpson were in attendance for the regular meeting at the Stoner home. The meeting was opened with prayer and the reading of the minutes.

Two lessons were prepared in advance on the "Two Emmaus Disciples" and "Thomas."

Reviewing the work, several questions were discussed regarding delinquents and regarding pupils rather advanced for their class.

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer in unison.

Pastor W. F. Doelling

27 April 1944

At the regular teachers' meeting at the Turner home there were present: Mrs. Stoner, Mrs. Simpson, Mrs. Turner, and the Pastor.

After opening the meeting with prayer, the Pastor presided the lesson on "Feed My Lambs" with the aid of the picturegraph and briefly spoke on "The Great Commission." Picturegraph numbers were given for four lessons in advance.

The junior class, formerly taught by Mrs. Doelling, is now being taught by Mrs. Simpson. The intermediate class has been combined with the senior class for the remainder of this term.

Since Miss Lorna Ake cannot take her class regularly and asked to be relieved, she was excused from the teaching staff. Mrs. Stoner will teach the Primary Class for the remainder of this school term.

The date of the Sunday School picnic and end of the Secondary School term was set at June 11th. The Young People's Society will be asked to sponsor this picnic again at the Shallow Beach, June 11th from 2-5 p.m. Parents of the children are to be invited.

We shall complete the full course of lessons for the second quarter by the end of the term by omitting the two reviews.

Picturegraph material on the Book of Acts is to be kept separate, just like that on Genesis and Luke.

During the discussion on Sunday School offerings for missions, the suggestion was adopted to give the children an opportunity on Mother's Day to bring offerings for the Army and Navy Commission collection.

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer in unison.

Pastor Daelling

11 May 1944

The teachers met at the parsonage. Pastor Daelling led in an opening prayer, read the minutes, and then explained lessons on the Ascension and Pentecost.

Advance lesson numbers for the picturegraph were given to the teachers.

Teachers will begin well in advance to gather material and ideas for our Sunday School picnic on June 11th.

One more meeting and, if needed, two more are to be held before the end of the school term.

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer.

25 May 1944

The teachers met at the Stoner home and, after opening the meeting with prayer, prepared lessons on "The Healing of the lame man" and "The Conversion of Saul."

Plans for the annual picnic include these: every teacher will provide and lead the sports and games for his own class; each teacher will also get the needed prizes for his own group.
